

Curriculum Bulletin - Y7 EPS3



What Will I Be Learning About This Half Term? We will be learning about Shakespearean Tragedy through the play 'Macbeth'. We will also be exploring language change and whether or not Shakespeare still English has relevance to modern society. Finally, we will be learning about transactional writing skills. We will be learning about fractions, percentages, ratio, area, volume and sequences Maths This half term we will be learning about Space, Forces, Electricity & Reproduction. Science We will be continuing to work on urban landscapes inspired by the famous artist Hundertwasser and will be introduced to the contemporary mask artist Art & Design Kimmy Cantrell Pupils will be designing and making a personalised picture frame (pine). We will be using a mixture of traditional hand tool skills and CAD/CAM to produce a **Design Technology** high quality product for a client of their choice. We will be learning about Urban Legends: This work explores the origin, function and Meaning. What do the stories tell us about our society or ourselves? Drama We will be learning about physical landscapes, with a focus on coastal landscapes and ecosystems. We will learn about how these landscapes have been Geography created by natural processes and how humans interact with them. We will be learning about 'The problems of Medieval monarchs'. Pupils will learn about the theme of the development of political power. This builds on the History 'religion in Medieval England', where pupils learned about the development of British society, political power and war and conflict. We will be learning about Computational Thinking and the main elements involved in it. This will build on work completed at KS2. We will then move onto ICT study Algorithms in more detail which is a key element of computational thinking. We will be learning about leisure activities and sporting hobbies that young people like to do in their free time. We will be looking at the present tense verbs of Languages iouer and faire. We will be learning about the relationship between identity, community and religious beliefs or faith, from the perspective of three world religions. Learning for Life Pupils are starting a new topic 'Composing to a Brief'. They will use Logic software to create compositions based around programme music. They will listen to Music programme music from a range of genres and composers. They will gain a greater understanding of music technology and develop their keyboard skills. Boys - We will be learning the skills, techniques and tactics in football and the physical and skill related components of health-related fitness and the methods **Physical Education** of training associated with them. Girls - We will be learning about Healthy lifestyles. This will target several fitness tests and components of fitness.
