



# Curriculum Bulletin - Y10 EPS4



## What Will I Be Learning About This Half Term?

<b>English</b>	Pupils will be learning how to achieve success with Language paper 1. In Literature we will be completing Power & Conflict poetry in the Anthology and revising 'DNA'.
<b>Maths</b>	Pupils studying the foundation syllabus will be learning about fractions and percentages followed by equations, while higher pupils will study percentages and ratio followed by graphs.
<b>Science</b>	This half term Year 10 will continue their GCSE studies by studying inheritance, variation and evolution in Biology. In Chemistry they will learn about quantitative analysis and energy transfers. In Physics they will study waves followed by forces and their effects.
<b>Computer Science</b>	Pupils will continue to learn different Programming techniques and look at how programs are created using defensive design techniques.
<b>Geography</b>	Pupils will be learning about urban change in the UK, with a focus on our capital city, London. They will learn about the opportunities and challenges people face in London and how the city is changing.
<b>French</b>	At EPS4 pupils will provide opinions about healthy living and express their new resolutions to stay fit. They will build on the vocabulary about sports and activities that they learnt at KS3.
<b>History</b>	Pupils will be learning about Weimar and Nazi Germany. This builds on 'The American West'. Pupils have learned about conflicts and conquest.
<b>ICT</b>	Pupils will be working on our controlled assessment worth 50% of the final mark for this course. The deadline for this is 3 April 2020.
<b>Learning for Life</b>	Pupils will be learning about the UK Criminal Justice System and its relationship with Christianity and the key Christian teachings of forgiveness.
<b>Spanish</b>	At EPS4 pupils will provide opinions about healthy living and express their new resolutions to stay fit. They will build on the vocabulary about sports and activities that they learnt at KS3.



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<b>Art and Design</b>	Pupils will be working on the theme of landscapes inspired by the contemporary artists Lucy Jones and Natalie Rymer.
<b>Dance</b>	This half term pupils will be working on the final section of our duet performance piece.
<b>Design Technology</b>	Pupils will be working towards completing Unit 1 of the course which is a 6 hour externally assessed exam, they will be building on their Revit, Google Sketch Up skills and be covering key theory based information to complete a feasibility report within the exam.
<b>Digital Art</b>	Pupils will continue their project until May creating and designing personal pieces in response to their theme.
<b>Drama</b>	DNA students will explore the play DNA through the role of director, designer and actor in preparation for their Year 11 set text exam.
<b>Enterprise and Marketing</b>	Pupils will be learning promotional objectives.
<b>Music</b>	Pupils are beginning to engage with the Beatles set works in preparation for the 8 mark questions in their listening exam. In addition to this they will be recapping the musical elements and focusing on their performance skills for their solo mock performance in the summer.
<b>Music Technology</b>	Pupils will continue with Unit 2 Creating music. In this unit pupils will research and listen to a range of genres and then recreate these in the form of original compositions. Work in this unit links directly to work completed in the written and practical exams next year. This term pupils will focus on the techniques and processes required to produce their own piece of music in their chosen style.
<b>Sport</b>	Pupils will be learning the rules, regulations and scoring systems of our second sport, whilst also performing practically and reviewing our own performance to analyse strengths and areas for improvement.
