

## **Curriculum Bulletin - Y11 EPS4**



## What Will I Be Learning About This Half Term?

English	Pupils are studying elements of both English Language papers and in Literature we have a focus on revising poetry, 'DNA' and 'A Christmas Carol'.
Maths	Pupils studying the foundation syllabus will be learning about vectors, similarity, percentages and simultaneous equations while higher pupils will study vectors, sequences and complex algebra.
Science	This half term, Year 11 will complete the B6 inheritance, variation and evolution unit in Biology. In Chemistry we will be learning about chemical analysis and how we use resources. In Physics we will be studying magnetism and electromagnetism. They will also complete a paper 2 mock exam.
Computer Science	Pupils will be revising key topic areas in preparation for the exam. We will be completing practice papers to aid this.
Geography	Pupils are preparing for their final examinations. This involves exam questions structured writing, writing up fieldwork investigations and studying pre-release material for paper 3.
German	This half-term, pupils will use their knowledge of the future tense and specific structures to talk about their plans regarding employment.
History	Pupils will be revising 'The American West' and 'Weimar and Nazi Germany'. This builds on Anglo-Saxon and Norman England.
ІСТ	Pupils will be preparing for the exam in May by revising key topic areas and completing practice papers.
Learning for Life	Pupils will be learning about the impact of Christian religious beliefs, customs and traditions on Christians daily lives in the modern world.
Spanish	This half-term, pupils will use their knowledge of the future tense and specific structures to talk about their plans regarding employment.



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Pupils will be putting finishing touches to their coursework and their mock examination and will commence preparation for their external 10 hour GCSE EXAM which starts on the 1 February 2020.
This half term pupils will be completing A Linha Curva and looking at Infra. We will also be completing our composition pieces.
Pupils will be working towards the AQA GCSE non exam assessment (NEA). They will be working on their own NEA producing a high quality design folio to a specific marking criteria along producing a practical prototype. All pupils will also be revising key content from exam which is to be sat in May.
Pupils will be starting their controlled assessment exam project.
Performing Students will explore and develop their performance skills through a portrayal of 2 contrasting scenes from one script, this will be performed for an examiner.
Pupils will be learning about evaluating our business idea and presentation.
Pupils are listening to a range of music from across the four AOS for their exam. They are rounding off both brief and free compositions ready for coursework submission in March.
This term pupils will continue Unit 3 sound recording. In this unit pupils will be recording musicians to produce and master a track. They will use a range of techniques that not only will be vital in this unit but will be transferable for the written and practical exam. They will also complete mock examinations in preparation for their official exams.
Pupils will be learning how to apply the principles of training to a fitness-based training programme and learning about the different body systems and how they effect performance.
