I'd like to thank the parents and carers who attended our virtual open evenings. Can I also thank those who have been in touch to pass on kind words about the events, they were gratefully received and we're just thrilled that we could provide you with the information that you require to help inform your decision making.

We do recognise that this might make places at Penketh more competitive to secure and some have questioned our decision, especially given the increased interest in the school following the transformational work undertaken by staff over the last three years.

We haven't taken this decision lightly but ultimately our passion is our pupils and ensuring that we do all we can to support them individually during their time at the school. We know our pupils so well and having these relationships with them and their families allows us to ensure they get the very best support. For us it's not about the numbers through the door but the quality of education and support we can provide to our young people. We felt that this smaller number of maximum pupils in a year group would help us to personalise their experience even more and ultimately support their ambitions for success.

Finally, I'd also like to extend my thanks to the parents who have passed on words of congratulations or encouragement following the news that our Maths department have been nominated for Maths Team/Teacher of the Year at the national TES awards 2020 and also following the announcement that Penketh High has been recognised by Government Initiatives IQ as a 100 Top Performing and Improving School 2020.

Like our positive Ofsted judgement earlier this year, these announcements serve as recognition for the staff at the school who have worked tirelessly on behalf of our pupils to undertake transformational work and for the pupils themselves who have risen to the challenge of higher expectations and standards.

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
