Residential Trip

Your child has attended an assembly today and been given their activities and details re rooms and been informed of rules whilst we are there.

As pupils arrive to school on Tuesday morning they should wear the clothes they want to do their first activity in (before 8:30am if possible), they are to go straight to the **gym** to hand in their **named luggage and medication** if applicable. If you have returned the medical form stating that your child takes medication, then this needs to be brought along in a clearly labeled box with dosage instructions. Pupils that do not have their medication with them will not be allowed to attend.

All pupils will need to bring a **packed lunch** with them for Tuesday. If your child is on Free school meals then this will be provided for them. **NO NUTS** please at all.

We will arrive back to school on Wednesday in time for normal school finishing time.
