

So, for example, your first lesson on a Monday A week might be Science, and then your first lesson on a Monday B week might be Maths.


Our buildings WHY DO WE HAVE DIFFERENT BUILDINGS ON OUR SITE?




Each building has lots of different classrooms. Each classroom has room number, which starts with the initial letter of the building.

For example, the first classroom in Ennis building is called E01. There are also different offices and places that you might need to go to. Our school is split into four different buildings: Ennis, Pankhurst Da Vinci, Riley.

Each building has different subjects and different teachers. You will have lessons across all of these buildings and you will quickly find your way around!



It might seem a bit scary now when you look at all of these buildings but don't worry! We are here to help you and you won't get into trouble for trying your best to find the rooms.



This is the first building you will probably see when you come into school.

The lessons you will do in this building are:

Maths - E01, E02, E03, E04, E05, E06, E20 and E21

Computing - E10, E11, E12, E13, E14 and E15 (this room is also used for Digital Art)

Personal Development and RE - E07 and E16

Music - E17 and E18

English - E25, E26, E27, E28, E29, E30 and E31

The Penketh Achievement Centre


The Penketh Achievement Centre is an area that you might be invited to attend for additional help and support with your learning. Teaching Assistants may work with you on a planned intervention session to support maths, reading, spelling, speech and language or memory. This will last for a set number of week and we will track your progress in these sessions.

You might also be invited to attend Chat and Chill which is a quiet area away from the main canteen where you can spend break and lunch.

In addition to the above we also offer a safe place where you can access support to regulate your feelings and emotions before returning to class; this could involve spending time in the sensory area, on the exercise bike, completing a social story or talking to a member of staff.

Staff in the Achievement Centre work closely with your teachers so that we can implement strategies to support you and ensure that any help you need is given.

This is where you will do your Science lessons. These rooms will look a bit different to the other classrooms in school.


Here you will learn about Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

There are also Science technicians who make sure everything is ready for all of the experiments you will do.




You will also have your P.E. lessons in Riley. You will do lots of different indoor and outdoor sports.

Sports: Mr Mullock, Miss Fleming and Miss Abbott.


What are our buildings called?

Write the names of the buildings on the lines below




Enrichment

WHAT IS ENRICHMENT? HOW IS THIS BUILT INTO THE CURRICULUM?

During period 6 and sometimes after school, you will have access to over 70 clubs and activities to take part in - we call this Enrichment. There are clubs running all over school - whatever you are interested in, you will find a club for you!



You will sign up to two Enrichment clubs that you will take part in each week. Every term, a new Enrichment timetable will be produced, so you can have a look for anything else that interests you.



Where black, these clubs have already ran previously so will not be able to be chosen, if you are aware that you already attend this club then you do not need to pick on that day.

We are here for you to talk to! When you start at Penketh High School, there will be certain people that you can speak to about your worries.

FORM TUTOR:

You will have a Form Tutor who you will see every day. Your form will have about 25 other pupils in it and you will meet together at least once every day. This is a great opportunity to make sure you have everything you need to have a successful day at school and to ask any questions you need answered.

HEAD OF YEAR:

You will also have a Head of Year. They will monitor and encourage you and your year group to ensure there are no barriers to your learning and enable you to make as much progress in your lessons as possible.

WELFARE:

We also have a Welfare area in school. This is somewhere you can go if you need support with your well-being. Here you might see Mrs Bewes,Mr Burke, Mrs Lewis or Mrs Smith.
