Dear **Parents and Carers**,

As part of our continued commitment to preparing pupils to sit exams at the end of Year 11, pupils will sit mock exams across all five years at Penketh High School. Pupils will be issued with individual exam timetables by their form tutors. You can obtain a copy of their timetable through the Arbor Parent App.

These mock exams provide an important opportunity for pupils to experience formal examination conditions and to identify areas for further development before entering Year 11.

Equipment Required

To ensure pupils are fully prepared, they must bring the following equipment to every exam:

- Black ink pens (at least two)
- Calculator (for permitted exams only)
- Ruler
- Protractor
- Pair of compasses

All equipment must be brought in a clear, transparent pencil case.

Pupils should also bring a clear, see through water bottle with no label attached. Only still water is permitted in the exam room. Under no circumstances should pupils bring flasks or large non-transparent water bottles.

Examination Expectations

These exams will be conducted under formal JCQ (Joint Council for Qualifications) examination regulations. It is essential that pupils understand the seriousness of these expectations, which include:

- No mobile phones, smartwatches, AirPods, or digital devices of any kind in the exam room
- No notes, revision materials, or unauthorised items
- Silence must be maintained at all times in the exam room
